Help make our Never Forget Garden and World War I Memorial a Reality!

Through an initiative started in 2018, the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier “Never Forget Garden” is a nationwide invitation to all Americans and freedom-loving people to plant gardens as a visual way to represent America’s unwavering commitment to our sacred duty to recognize, remember, and honor our veterans, many who continued to serve as first responders, and their families now and for many years to come.

We began a “Never Forget Garden” here in Mount Olivet in the fall of 2021. It is located within a circle lot surrounded by Areas T, U, and S, leading us to recall a Kiosk/Gazebo structure that once stood on this site from 1915 to the 1950s.

This sparked an idea to re-create the Kiosk/Gazebo in the form of a World War I Memorial to complement our World War II Memorial a few hundred yards away, officially dedicated on Memorial Day, 1948. Thanks to a generous donation by the Delaplaine Foundation, we have our gazebo but have additional work to properly finish. We also have a desire to add benches, a flag pole, and three interpretive waysides which will tell the stories of some of the 600 WWI veterans resting in our midst here.
